Their eyes and nostrils are positioned on top of their heads, which allows them to see and breathe while the rest of their body is underwater, pretty cool huh?



Now, taking a swim in the waters with our caiman friend, let's explore what they munch on. Broad-snouted caimans are carnivores,

which means they love to eat meat. Their diet mainly consists of fish, amphibians, and small mammals that they find near or in the water. Sometimes, they even eat insects and birds if they can catch them!

From munching on a fish, let's dive into where these caimans love to hang out. They are found in South America, in countries like Argentina, Brazil, and Paraguay. They prefer freshwater habitats like rivers, lakes, and marshes where they can camouflage and wait for their prey. But do you know, during the dry season when their watery homes shrink, they can dig burrows in the mud to stay cool and hydrated - they are smart, aren't they?
